One of the most exciting things for me about this book is that it is being authored by a woman who as a teenager was a refugee from the former Czechoslovakia, and came to Christ through our refugee ministry in Austria over 20 years ago! She has given of her time and talent in order to bless our ministry in this way. She wants no credit and she wants no profit. She only wants to bless. And God is certainly using her in that way.

Is this something you think you can invest in? We are doing a combination of self-publishing with professional company assistance. We are doing "print-on-demand", and we will also be making e-books, available by download.

Will you pray about this? Pray for wisdom for us, encouragement for those who read this book, for funds to get it going and funds to go back into the ministry. Pray if God may want to use you in this way.
