Possible FUTURE Ministry...?

A door of opportunity is opening for **Nader & Ella Mohajer to partner with a church in Norway doing ministry among Persian refugees!** Evangelism, church-planting, pastoring and discipleship training would be their primary focus. After meeting with the leadership there, spending much time in prayer, and trying very hard to hear God's voice, all the lights seem to be green...except for one (finances). (Additionally, living and working in Norway will eventually provide the Mohajers with a **long-term legal status** that they have not been able to acquire in Greece. Anyone who has never been "country-less" cannot imagine the emotional and practical burdens and difficulties this brings to even the simplest matters of everyday life). **Because the Mohajers have neither a "sending church" from their home countries (Iran and the Philippines), nor a "supporting church" here in Athens** (they have been pastoring the Persian Christian Fellowship--made up of mostly Muslim seekers and refugees who are new believers), we are trying to discern if God wants to use Christians in the west to help. They need **\$1,500 USD MORE** (per month) in order to be able to live and minister in Norway. If you break it down to 20 people/churches/small groups investing \$75 a month, it is not unimaginable, especially if God is the one guiding and providing, right?! Or 40 giving just over \$37 a month! Whether it is more or less than \$75 a month is not important. **ANY AMOUNT will be helpful!** And if you are already supporting them monthly, would you pray that God will raise up others and MAYBE use you to help recruit them (friends, Sunday School class, co-workers, missions committee, etc.)? Checks may be written to **International Teams**. Enclose a note designating "for Nader & Ella Mohajer".
